CLIFTON PARK, NY--The residents of the Shenendehowa School District have voted to approve the School District's agreement to sell 37 acres of surplus land to the Town of Clifton Park. Friends of Clifton Park Open Space (FRIENDS) is extremely pleased with this result.

FRIENDS believe that the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the two public entities, along with a well-established town process for engaging the public in dialog and workshops to develop the town's public spaces, will ensure the permanent protection of this acreage. This MOU outlines a planning process for the land and establishes a joint committee to explore opportunities for shared services to enhance access to the parcel and surrounding lands solely for public purposes.

We also believe that this beautiful space will provide protection to the nearby elementary schools along with potential outdoor classroom activities. Furthermore, a public amenity like this park will also help increase both sales tax revenue to the towns and increased property values for local residents year over year. It is truly a win-win proposition.
